Dear Caterpillar healthcare participant,

You are receiving this letter to inform you that Imitrex, a brand name triptan used to treat migraines, now has generic versions available called **sumatriptan**.

Our records indicate that you or your dependent have filled a prescription for a brand name triptan (Amerge[®], Axert[®], Frova[®], Imitrex[®], Maxalt[®], Relpax[®], Zomig[®]). The following is important information regarding your prescription medication.

Effective August 1, 2010, the following **quantity limits** apply:

- Amerge[®], Axert[®], Frova[®], Imitrex[®] (sumatriptan), Maxalt[®], Maxalt MLT[®], Relpax[®], Zomig[®] or Zomig ZMT[®] – 9 pills per month
 - Imitrex[®] injectable – 3 kits (6 injections per month) (no change to current quantity limits)
 - Imitrex Nasal Spray[®] and Zomig Nasal Spray[®] – 6 per month (no change to current quantity limits)
- Members will be responsible for paying 100% of the cost for any quantity exceeding the plan's limits.

Oral Triptans

Effective November 1, 2010, patients (age 18 and over) who take any of the following brand name medications will be required to have tried sumatriptan before any of the oral triptans listed below will be considered for coverage.

Amerge[®] tabs

Axert[®] tabs

Frova[®] tabs

Maxalt and Maxalt MLT[®] tabs

Relpax[®] tabs

Zomig and Zomig ZMT[®] tabs

Nasal Triptans

Effective November 1, 2010, use of **Imitrex Nasal Spray[®]** or **Zomig Nasal Spray[®]** will require your physician to submit a prior authorization request to Restat for a coverage determination.

You may wish to take this letter to your physician prior to November 1, 2010, to discuss potential options or alternatives* with him/her.
